Higher Awards for Non-Animal Departments

If Judges would like to consider an exhibit for a higher award, they will mark the exhibits with a star on the entry tag that is attached to the exhibit. These exhibits will be set aside/gathered at the end of judging and evaluated by Department to receive Best of Show and Awards of Merit.

Explanation of Awards:

Best of Show (Purple Rosette) – The highest award a non-animal exhibit can earn. Top 1% of all exhibits. All departments receive at least one Best of Show ribbon to give out...but in smaller departments judges may decide not to award a Best of Show if there are no outstanding exhibits they would like to recognize. A "Best of Show" in non-animal projects is equivalent to a "Champion" in the animal exhibits.

2021 Update: Best of Show is replacing State Fair Awards AND Special Plaques. A new LARGE rosette in purple is being created for Best of Show this year.

- State Fair Award Eliminated due to changes in State Fair's process. County Fairs are no longer the "qualifying event" for State Fair. Any youth ages 12-19 may enter to exhibit at the state fair.
- Award of Merit (Yellow Rosette) Second highest award a youth can receive on their non-animal project. Approximately 2-3% of exhibits can receive this award. An "Award of Merit" in non-animal projects is equivalent to a "Reserve Champion" in the animal exhibits.
- Honorable Mention (Light Blue Standard Ribbon) Any "starred" projects that did not receive a Best of Show or Award of Merit will receive a light blue Honorable Mention ribbon.

NOTE: Starred exhibits cannot receive more than one Higher Fair Award. They will either get "Best of Show" OR "Award of Merit" OR "Honorable Mention"

Other Special Awards:

- 4-H Programs sometimes use County Fair as the "qualifying" event for higher level 4-H Shows/Exhibits. These awards can only be given to 4-H members and can be given in addition to the Fair Awards. This is the only time an exhibit may receive more than one award.

- Outstanding EXHIBITOR any award entitled "outstanding exhibitor" are not being given in the
 animal OR non-animal departments for the 2021 Fair. As we've been reviewing our awards and
 processes we discovered that the outstanding exhibitor process is very inconsistent from Dept. to
 Dept. In order to create a more meaningful and inclusive process across all departments, we will be
 reviewing what it means to be an Outstanding Exhibitor and taking the time to create a quality process
